**[PROPOSED] ORDER MAKING PERMANENT THE PRELIMINARY WRIT OF  
PROHIBITION**

In accordance with this Court’s Opinion of \_\_\_\_\_, 2016, the preliminary writ of prohibition granted on April 19, 2016 is made permanent. Respondents are ordered to refrain from all action in the premises, except as regards proceedings to determine the subject-matter jurisdiction of the Missouri Ethics Commission and Administrative Hearing Commission in this case. In conducting such proceedings, both Parties shall be entitled to discovery going solely to that question, including the legal sufficiency of the underlying complaint in this action and the circumstances surrounding its filing. Unless and until Respondents are satisfied as to subject-matter jurisdiction, and have ruled to that effect, no other proceedings may commence.
