## <u>ORDER</u>

AND NOW, this / of November, 2021, upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction (Doc. No. 4), Defendants' Response in Opposition (Doc. No. 44), and the Court having conducted a hearing on November 8, 2021 and November 12, 2021, it is **ORDERED** that the Motion (Doc. No. 4) is **GRANTED**. Defendants are hereby **ENJOINED**, pending final judgment, from enforcing:

- 1. Pennsbury School Board Policy 903's prohibitions of speech deemed "personally directed," "abusive," "irrelevant," "offensive," "otherwise inappropriate," or "personal attacks;"
- 2. Pennsbury School Board Policy 922's prohibitions of speech deemed "offensive," "inappropriate," "intolerant," "disruptive," and "verbally abusive;" and
- 3. Pennsbury School Board Policy 903's requirement that speakers at public comment periods preface their remarks by announcing their address.<sup>1</sup>
